

Last summer, thanks to a partnership between Oscoda Township and the Oscoda Lions Club a Splash Pad was installed in the middle of the park. This approximate 300 sq. foot pad features 3 above ground fixtures and 4 flush ground nozzles that allow children and parents alike another way to cool down and have fun during the warm summer months!

The Skateboard Park improvements have begun in 2016. As soon as the snow melted away...the remaining old wood ramps were removed and new steel ramps were installed by a company called American Ramp Company. A concrete retaining wall will be installed along the East side of the pad to serve the dual purpose of seating and protection from blowing sand. This project was made possible by a grant that Oscoda Township was successful in obtaining through the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund Recreation Passport Grant program.

TOWNSHIP ZONING PERMITS

Oscoda Township is a zoned community and maintains an enforceable zoning ordinance. Permits are required for all construction activities; signs, fences, garages, sheds just to name a few. It also governs building sizes, number of accessory buildings allowed and commercial activities. Further, the ordinance specifies setback requirements which must be followed for placement of structures from property and lot lines. Permits must be obtained prior to the start of any such activities. For questions contact Zoning at 989-739-9019.

*You may register to vote at the Clerk's Office any day Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. *Permits are required and available at the Clerk's Office for any garage, basement, estate, and rummage type sales. Permits are free of charge, there is a 3 day limit on the number of sequential days you may hold your sale and there is a limit of a total of 4 sales per year per address. *A new system will allow everyone to subscribe to the Township's documents on the web site under the **"Minutes-On-Demand"** line on our home page.
